USER ADMINISTRATOR

Manage the individuals who can access your instance by defining them as users in the system. Create user groups, and assign users to them. Use roles to specify what different users and user groups can see and do.

This includes all of the permissions that are granted to a standard user account plus the ability to make major operating system changes, install new software, and create and modify other user accounts. Administrator accounts also have the ability to set permissions for other users on the system.

DATABASE BACKUP ADMINISTRATOR

Backup and Restore Overview. Database backup and restore operations in MarkLogic Server are distributed over all of the data nodes in a cluster (that is, all of the nodes that contain forests), and provide consistent database-level backups and restores.

As a backup administrator, your principal duty is to devise, implement, and manage a backup and recovery strategy. In general, the purpose of a backup and recovery strategy is to protect the database against data loss and reconstruct the database after data loss.
